Notes

For 4 or more participants in a vehicle, a hard-sided suitcase is not required due to limited storage space. All guests need a soft bag which is limited to 15 kg total weight. For the safari we recommend bringing comfortable sturdy shoes, beige, green or brown comfortable clothing with long sleeved pants and shirts. Also, be sure to carry sunscreen with SPF 30 or higher, a brimmed hat and sunglasses. A small first-aid kit and insect repellent recommended. All guests need a visa for entry into Tanzania and passports need to be valid for 6 more months at the time of entry.

Day 2 - Moshi - Tarangire National Park

After being picked up from your hotel in Moshi, you will drive to Tarangire National Park, which is particularly known for its large number of elephants. The name of the park comes from the river of the same name, which is the only source of water for the wild animals in the dry season. The national park is an elongated park with a varied landscape. Hills, savannah landscape and swamps alternate. The huge baobab trees are impressive.

Day 3 - Tarangine - Lake Manyara

Today the safari takes you to Lake Manyara National Park. You will leave your lodge at Tarangire and drive via the southern park entrance to Lake Manyara National Park. You will pass the hot springs where many bird species gather and buffalo are often seen. Giraffes, zebras and elephants live in large numbers in Manyara Park and offer unique game-viewing opportunities. In the afternoon, you will reach the Hippo Pool, a favourite waterhole for these impressive animals. Flamingos and pelicans can often be seen on the horizon before you leave the park and continue to your lodge.

Day 4 – Lake Manyara - Serengeti National Park

After breakfast, you will head to the famous Serengeti National Park. On your way, you will pass the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, the “African Eden”, which has a very rich variety of vegetation and species. Soft hills, dormant volcanoes and stunning jungles provide a breath-taking view. During migration from January to March, millions of wildebeests and zebras pass the Serengeti Plains and the edges of Ngorongoro. When you enter Serengeti through the Nabi Gate, you will have an impressive first impression.

This day begins in the heart of Serengeti, the Seronera Valley, among umbrella thorn acacias and huge fig trees. The range of hills in the north feed several waterholes which attract numerous impalas, antelopes, reedbucks and baboons. Hippos splash around in the water, leopards rest on the acacias and lions take naps in the high grass. This day is completely devoted to game drives in Serengeti. You can decide how you would like to organize the day.

Day 6 - Serengeti - Ngorongoro Crater

In the early morning, the drive begins directly to the Ngorongoro Crater, which you will reach at lunchtime. At the park entrance, the view opens up into the huge crater bowl, of which Bernhard Grzimek said: "You cannot describe the crater." The entire Ngorongoro Conservation Area covers a total area of 8,292 square kilometers and consists of towering escarpments, undulating grasslands and low-lying swamps. Here, lions, hyenas, zebras, wildebeests, warthogs, impalas, Thomson's gazelles and over 500 bird species find everything they need to live. Once on the crater floor, the game drive begins.

Day 7 – Ngorongoro Crater - Arusha - Zanzibar

After a hearty breakfast, we travel back to Arusha including a visit to Mto wa Mbu, Village Market Tour. Colourful cloths line along the main street of Mto wa Mbu as well as different kind of bananas and other fruits. Even artistic paintings look like a gracious canvas. Mto wa Mbu offers a versatility rarely seen in other Tanzanian towns. On the tour to the market, you will be accompanied by a guide and get an impression of the diversity.

After the unforgettable impressions of the past few days in Tanzania's unique national parks with their large animal populations, today you will board a plane to Zanzibar, where the second and quieter part of your journey begins. You are flying with Auric Airline. The total baggage allowance is 20kg (15 kg luggage and 5 kg hand luggage). Upon arrival at Zanzibar Airport, you will be met by your driver who will be transferring you to your accommodation.

Day 8 – Stone Town City Tour and Spice Tour - Matemwe

After breakfast you will check out of the hotel and embark on a guided City Tour of Stone Town, a vibrant and historic hub located about halfway along Zanzibar's west coast. The city's rich cultural heritage is brought to life as you explore, the famous Zanzibar doors, visit the bustling Market with its fresh tropical fruits and vegetables, and observe the lively fish market where auctions take place. Historical highlights include the Sultan's Palace Museum, the Old Arab Fort, the Anglican Church, the African House, the House of Wonders, the former English Club and Forodhani Park.

In the afternoon, you will continue your exploration of Zanzibar with a Spice Tour, a guided walk through the island's famous spice farms. Learn about the wide variety of spices that have shaped Zanzibar's economy and history since the 16th century. This full day offers a fascinating insight into Zanzibar's culture, history, and flavours, combining the vibrant streets of Stone Town with the fragrant spice plantations that make the island unique. Please wear comfortable shoes, a long-sleeved shirt and long pants on this tour. After your Spice tour, you will be transferred to Matemwe on Zanzibar's northeast coast, home to one of the world's most beautiful coral beaches.
